Important information

Always dial 999 in an emergency. The ambulance service will respond as quickly as possible. The CPAD does not replace the ambulance service but the defibrillator can be used to save lives once the ambulance service have been called.

***Keycode** locks are delivered with a random code which you must record; see card attached to the cabinet. **It is important that you speak with your ambulance service,** they may want you to use a specific code. This cabinet and code must be registered with the ambulance service Computer Aided Despatch (CAD); when a 999 call is made the defibrillator can then be located and accessed.

CPADS must be registered with the local ambulance trust. SADS UK is not responsible for the running of a CPAD scheme.

Visual checks of the AED status indicator must be carried out regularly.
